Bible Verses which Support the idea of Corporal Resurrection



- Matthew 27:52 “ . . . the tombs were opened and the many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep *were raised*, and coming out of the tombs after his resurrection, they went into the holy city and *appeared to many*.”
- John 11:38-44 Lazarus is raised from the dead. [miracle (Jn 10:38)- not eternal]
- Luke 24:36-42 “ . . . touch me and see, a ghost does not have flesh and bones, as you see I have.”

• Luke 24:36-39 "...But they were terrified... and supposed they had seen a ghost..."

Mark 16:12 "... he appeared in a different form..."


1 Corinthians 15:4-8 Who saw him? Peter, the apostles, and 500 others.

... So also is the resurrection of the dead...


... It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body."


