

1. The Last Days

2. End of the two-thousand-year-long New Testament Age

• We call the time of Christ's Second Advent the Last Days.

• The Principle of Restoration reveals that Christ returns at the end of the 2,000-year New Testament Age, the age of the Prolongation of the Providence of Restoration, which restored the previous 2,000 year age through substantial parallel conditions of indemnity.

•In Luke 17:25, Jesus made a prediction about the Lord at his return: "But first he must suffer many things and be rejected by this generation."

•Jesus foresaw that at the Second Advent, the Christians would be likely to persecute the Christ and condemn him as a heretic when he is born in the flesh. That is why he foretold that the Lord would suffer and be rejected by his generation.

**3.1 Will Christ Return among the Jewish People?**

Rev. 7:4, Matt. 10:23, and Matt. 16:28

- Among the Jewish people
  - Matt. 21:33-43
- Not among the Jewish people

Chosen people after crucifixion: Christians

- Therefore, the chosen people after Jesus' crucifixion are not the descendants of Abraham, but rather the Christians who have inherited the faith of Abraham.
- Jesus clearly conveyed that he would not come again to the people who persecuted him. God will take away the mission previously entrusted to them and give it to another people who can produce its fruits upon Christ's return.



**Three Eastern Nations**

→

China

Would become Communist

Fascist, persecuted Korean Christianity

- Since ancient times, the nations in the East have traditionally been considered to be the three nations of Korea, Japan and China.
- Japan entered the period of the Second Advent as a fascist nation and severely persecuted Korean Christianity. China at this time was a hotbed of communism and would become a communist nation. Thus, both nations belonged to Satan's side.
- Korea, then, is the nation in the East where Christ will return. Korea had to meet the following qualifications:

- At the fall of the first human ancestors, God's side and Satan's side parted ways from a single point.

- The First Israel suffered four hundred years in Egypt in order to fulfill a dispensation of forty for the separation of Satan.
- The Second Israel had to prevail over the four hundred years of persecution in the Roman Empire.

- As the Third Israel, the Korean people had also to suffer under a nation on Satan's side for a period to fulfill a dispensation of forty for the separation of Satan. This was the forty-year period during which Korea suffered untold hardships as a colony of Japan. (1905 – 1945)

**3.3.3 The Object Partner of God's Heart**

1. Path of blood, sweat and tears
2. People of goodness

- To become the object partners of God's Heart, we must first walk a path of blood, sweat and tears.
- The nation qualified to stand as the object partner of God's Heart must be a people of goodness. The homogeneous Korean people rarely invaded other nations.

### 3.3.3 The Object Partner of God's Heart

1. Path of blood, sweat and tears
2. People of goodness
3. By nature endowed with a religious character (worship God; loyalty, filial piety and chastity)

- The Korean people are by nature endowed with a religious character. They have evinced a strong desire to worship God, and always revered the virtues of loyalty, filial piety and chastity.

### 3.3.4 Messianic Prophecies

1. Messianic idea among the Korean people (Chonggamnok)
  2. Revelations that religious founders will return to Korea
- The Korean people have long believed in the prophecy that the Righteous King will appear and found a glorious and everlasting kingdom in their land. This messianic idea was first revealed through the Chonggamnok, a 14th Century book of prophecy.
  - The faithful of every religion in Korea have received revelations that the founder of their religion will return to Korea.

### 3.3.4 Messianic Prophecies

1. Messianic idea among the Korean people (Chonggamnok)
  2. Revelations that religious founders will return to Korea
  3. Revelations and signs (Acts 2:17)
  4. Clear revelations that the Lord will come to Korea
- Revelations and signs are being given to spiritually attuned Christians testifying to the Second Coming of Christ in Korea.
  - Many are receiving clear revelations that the Lord will come to Korea.





# The Second Advent

Time of Jesus → Today (Second Advent)  
Judaism → Christianity

1. *Overemphasis on authority, ceremony / spiritual corruption and decline*
2. *Possibility to persecute Christ*

•The period of the Second Advent is parallel to the time of Jesus, and the two periods have many similarities. Just like the Judaism of Jesus' day, the Church sometimes values institution and ceremony over the purity of original faith.

•For this reason Christian leaders, like the Jewish leaders of Jesus' day, may be the first to persecute Christ at the Second Coming.

Time of Jesus → Today (Second Advent)  
Judaism → Christianity

1. *Overemphasis on authority, ceremony / spiritual corruption and decline*
2. *Possibility to persecute Christ*
3. *Mainstream rejects new Biblical insight*
4. *Heaven or Hell?*

•Pure-hearted Christians, and even non-Christians may accept the Lord's words before those Christian leaders who regard themselves as the elect. Jesus tells us that many believers who set out with the hope of entering Heaven may actually find themselves in hell. (Mt 7:23)
