Thank you. What a pleasure. Respected Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, thank you for your vision and commitment to building a world of universal and lasting peace. Congratulations on the occasion of your 80th birthday.

World Unity and the Reunification of South and North Korea Will Be Accomplished by True Love

Distinguished guests whose fervent desire is for North-South re-unification, ladies and gentlemen:

I would like to begin by thanking you for congratulating me on my eightieth birthday. Most of all, I would like to ascribe to God all the honor and glory given to me, for it is He who has protected me until this day.

I have spoken publicly on more than ten thousand occasions around the world. In these speeches I set forth a true view of humanity, a true view of the world, and a true view of history based on Godism.

These speeches have been translated into twelve languages and published in three hundred volumes. I did not arrive at the content of these speeches from a study of historical documents. My conclusions are not the result of scholarly research. Rather, I arrived at these answers to our basic and fundamental questions through direct communication with both the visible and invisible worlds.

The reunification of the Korean Peninsula is the solemn desire of our people and the final act that will bring the global Cold War to a conclusion. So today, as I express my gratitude for your having prepared this meaningful forum, I would like to outline the basic solution for bringing about unification by

speaking on the topic, "World Unity and the Reunification of South and North Korea Will Be Accomplished by True Love."

Human history is the history of the providence of restoration

Human history is the history of the providence of restoration through indemnity, which is purposed to restore the original world that was lost due to the Fall of the first ancestors. Therefore, it is a history of the struggle between good and evil taking place between Satan's side and God's side.

In the background of history, good spirits have always supported the good side, and evil spirits have incited the evil side. The history of division that began through the human Fall has expanded in scope to the levels of family, tribe, people, nation and world. Now it is being manifested as the fight between materialism and theism.

If two thousand years ago the people had accepted Jesus, he would have brought together Judaism and the people of that tradition, and then worked with them to unite the parts of the Levant inhabited by the descendants of Jacob's twelve tribes. They would have then propagated Jesus' teachings throughout the Middle East region and to the Indian sub-continent all the way to the Far

East. At the same time, Jesus' teachings would have won the heart of the Roman Empire and Europe. In this way, Jesus would have realized one united world during his lifetime. As the center of this new religious and cultural realm, Jesus would have become the King of kings.

Tragically, he died on the cross. Rome had already developed its central culture based on Hellenism, an externally oriented humanistic culture centered on the physical body. Christianity, in contrast, was a theistic culture grounded in Hebraism, an internally oriented culture that centered on the mind. It suffered persecution from Rome and its Hellenistic culture for four hundred years.

God's strategy for Satan's natural surrender

God is eternal, unchanging, absolute and unique, and the standard of the ideal that He has held to since the beginning of creation must also have these qualities. If you ask God directly, I think He will confirm what I am saying.

From this perspective, there is amazing truth in God's teaching, "Love your enemy." In fact, this is one of God's strategies in His battle against evil. These words sound simple. Yet few realize that they mark the boundary line between victory





to want to be with others regardless of whether they are higher or lower, front or back, left or right.

What is the common denominator among those who say, "I want to live in harmony with others?" It is not power. Power cannot transcend history. Whatever power one has is for a limited period of time.

The same is true of knowledge. The world of knowledge is always changing. Does knowledge give us the desire to say, "I want to live with this particular piece of knowledge forever"? Clearly, we cannot keep either knowledge or wealth with us forever. What, then, is the common denominator that transcends above and below, front and back, left and right, and the changes of history across past, present and future? It is nothing else than true love centering on God.

North-South reunification through true love

Even communist ideology will be easily absorbed and disappear when it is placed in the midst of God's love. The problem until now was that we did not know this. Once we develop our hearts of love, North-South unification will be no problem at all.

That is not all. Problems between East and West, and the worldwide North-South problem created by the inequality between rich and poor nations, can also be completely resolved through the true love of God.

We must fulfill the ideal for the world centering on God's ideal that I have described, if we are to realize the ideal for our nation. Then we have to move on to the boundless realm of peace, the ideal world that links the ideal of the nation to the ideals of clan, family, and individual. This is, without a doubt, the way that the ideal world of true love that God has long desired can be built on this earth.

I conclude this speech hoping once again that my words today will develop into an international movement that can advance the day when North and South Korea can meet and harmonize together in true love.

I pray for God's blessing to be with you and your families.

and defeat in the battle between God and Satan.

It is under these conditions that God has pursued the providence, centering on the Christian cultural sphere. Whether we have to sacrifice our possessions or even become martyrs, in the midst of the bloody battle we must build a movement that loves God and loves our enemies. We have to build this movement in our families, in our societies, and in our nations.

The Roman Empire persecuted Christianity severely; nevertheless, it ended up surrendering in the face of the power of Christians' love for the country that was their enemy. This is how Christianity became a worldwide religion. Christians found the starting point of the path to heaven within the country that was their enemy. These days, Christians think about loving individual people who are their enemies, but that is not enough. We have to love the country that is our enemy, and even the world that is our enemy.

The starting point on the path to heaven is within the country of our enemy.

The plan for North-South reunification

Distinguished ladies and gentlemen, all the people in North Korea have

armed themselves with Juche ideology. We must arm ourselves with the philosophy of true love that is capable of encompassing them. The Korean people of both North and South fervently desire to see their country reunited. How can this be accomplished? Their reunification can only be accomplished when a sophisticated method is put forward that will allow both sides to live together on terms that both can agree on. When the South goes to the North, or the North to the South, and says, "Let's do it our way," unification will not come about. Thus, we must find a love that will benefit both sides.

Where and how will North-South reunification come about?

Thus, the only way to unite North and South is to become a people who can die for both the North and the South, with the heart of truly wanting to live together in harmony with the other side. There is no other path to achieve unity.

When a person considers how to lead his life, the fundamentals can be expressed as: the path of a filial child, the path of a loyal patriot, the path of a saint, and the path of a son or daughter of God. Each of these stages expresses the heart of wanting to live in harmony with others eternally. Logically, the summit of this path is

Today we are speaking about peace—peace in our world. Throughout human history people have sought to realize a world of peace, yet we have always experienced war and conflict. How and when will peace come to humankind?

Attaining the Fulfillment of Human History and Divine Providence

Originally, the Creator's intention was to be our parent. The invisible Creator created a man and a woman in the image of God as our first ancestors. God gave them time to mature and waited for the day when they would perfect their characters. Nevertheless, the man and woman who were to have been our first ancestors failed to uphold God's divine commandment, and their descendants are the fallen human race of the present day.

PEACE SUMMIT 2023

Pace Summit 2023, a momentous gathering of global leaders, convened in Seoul, Korea, from May 2 to 6 at the esteemed Lotte Hotel in Jamsil. The Sunhak Peace Prize Conference was held on May 3rd, with the participation of esteemed members of the Sunhak Peace Prize Selection Committee, laureates, and international figures. The Sunhak Peace Prize Conference was held on May 3rd as a time to explore the progressive future of world peace, with the participation of Sunhak Peace Prize selection committee members, laureates, and international figures. The attendees expressed deep concerns about the current global situation, in which their countries prioritize nationalism due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the aftermath of the Russia-Ukraine war. They gathered in appreciation of the founder's vision of peace and the significance of the Sunhak Peace Prize as a valuable presence amid the bleak times, in embracing "all humanity as one family".

Dr. Sakena Yacoobi, a laureate of the Sunhak Peace Prize, expressed her sincere belief that the Sunhak Peace Prize has made a positive impact on the world. The students of Cheongshim International Academy, who will grow up to be global leaders, considered meeting the prestigious Sunhak Peace Prize laureates a great honor and expressed their aspirations to receive the Sunhak Peace Prize in the future.

During the summit, the first laureate of the Sunhak Peace Prize, H.E. Anote Tong, former President of the Republic of Kiribati, and Dr. Sakena Yacoobi were key speakers at major programs, such as the Think Tank 2022 Forum, IAYSP Conference, and the International Association of Academicians for Peace Symposium, where they introduced practical activities for peace. 



THINK TANK 2022 FORUM

THINK TANK 2022 Forum Explores Path of Coexistence Amid Power Struggles

The 6th THINK TANK 2022 Forum, held on May 4th, brought together over 800 global leaders and experts to discuss the theme of “The Era of Power Struggles: Seeking the Path of Coexistence.” The forum provided a significant platform for addressing global challenges and finding solutions that go beyond the reunification of Korea, aiming to foster a unified global community based on coexistence rather than confrontation.

The event focused on addressing security risks in Northeast Asia and developing strategies for establishing a peaceful global order. Esteemed participants included Prime Minister Albin Kurti of Kosovo, former President Thomas Boni Yayi of Benin, former Minister of Defense Werner Fasslabend of Austria, Representative Lee Jeong-mun of the Democratic Party, and Chairman Kim Geun-sik of the Korea National Unification Advisory Council.

Dr. Yun Young-Ho, Chairman of the THINK TANK 2022 Forum Organizing Committee, highlighted the global situation in his welcome address, referring to the War in Ukraine and the rise of China as factors contributing to an imbalance in global politics and an increased potential for conflict. The Korean Peninsula, situated at the intersection of major powers, faces such imbalances, making peaceful reunification unlikely under the current circumstances. However, achieving reunification is crucial in resolving the struggle for hegemony between China and the US, which extends beyond a mere politico-economic dispute to a battle between Communism and Democracy.

During his keynote speech, Michael Pillsbury, Senior Fellow, China Strategy, Heritage Foundation, USA, cautioned against accepting China’s outwardly friendly image without careful examination. He emphasized the need to be vigilant about China’s ambitions and highlighted China’s historical reliance on force and deception behind a façade of mysticism. Understanding China accurately,



including its economic growth through various means, is of utmost importance. Pillsbury stressed the significance of providing solutions rather than solely identifying problems.

Former Secretary of State Mike Pompeo delivered a speech emphasizing the pursuit of peace aligned with Mother Moon's objectives. He discussed the three summits with Chairman Kim Jong Un, acknowledging the totalitarian nature of North Korea and its threat to global peace, alongside the Chinese Communist Party. Pompeo advocated for upholding property rights, decency, and human rights, firmly asserting Taiwan's separate country status. He emphasized the importance of embracing truth and factual understanding to prevent conflict and achieve peace. Pompeo expressed goodwill towards the Chinese people while criticizing the heartless regime's pursuit of a model that leads to poverty and war. He encouraged conference participants to foster peace and hope through prayer.

Kim Geun Sik, Chair of the Unification Committee of the People Power Party, shared his personal observations on the evolving relationship with China, noting a shift towards closer ties with Japan. Reflecting on past progress made through the Six-Party Talks and the separation of economic and security concerns, he called for a paradigm shift in diplomatic and security matters in the current new Cold War era. Geun Sik advocated for a strong alliance with Japan and the US, emphasizing that the collapse of the North Korean regime is necessary for a resolution. He highlighted the importance of democracy and human rights in countering China's hegemony and upholding international agreements. Geun Sik stressed the preservation of democratic values and the implementation of cooperative and peaceful solutions.

Participants at the event also recognized the interconnectedness between the Korean Peninsula issue and China, engaging in robust discussions on the contentious cross-strait conflict, which has become the central battleground of the US-China rivalry in the Asian region. 



The International Association of Academicians for Peace (IAAP) Session: Global Symposium on Academics

The grand Lotte Hotel in Jamsil served as the elegant venue for the International Academic Symposium on May 4, 2023. Orchestrated by the Hyojeong Academic Foundation and the Universal Peace Federation (UPF), the symposium revolved around the compelling theme “Vision of Peace Ideology and Peace Movement.” The esteemed event garnered the attendance of over 150 global leaders and scholars.

Moderated by Thomas Selover, the erstwhile president of the Professors World Peace Academy (PWPA), the symposium unfolded with warm welcome remarks. These were delivered by Thomas Walsh, the chairman of UPF International, and Jin Seong Bae, the chairman of the Hyojeong Academic Foundation. The event was further adorned by a congratulatory speech from Sakena Yacoobi, hailed as the mother of education in Afghanistan and a laureate of the Sunhak Peace Prize. Insightful presentations filled Sessions 1 and 2, followed by an interactive question-and-answer segment.

Session 1, themed “Vision of Peace Ideology and Peace Movements Across Continents: The Role of Religion in Each Continent,” featured profound presentations. Nevers Mumba, the former Vice President of Zambia, spoke eloquently about the urgent tasks for a global order and fostering a culture of peace. Dr. Mohammad Habash delved into the Middle East perspective of peace ideology and the influential role of religions in shaping peace movements. Lastly, Frank Kaufmann, the president of the Professors World Peace Academy, expressed spiritual and political concerns regarding Western civilization post the iconic image of a crucifix.

Session 2 embraced the theme “Vision and Peace Ideology for Peace Movements: The Role of UN and UPF on Each Continent.” Here, Mahendra Lama, a senior professor of international studies at Jawaharlal Nehru University in New Delhi, offered an Asian perspective on soft power, public diplomacy, and alternative paradigms for constructing world peace. Dr. Rojas Aravena, the 8th Rector of the University for Peace (UPEACE), stressed the necessity for dialogue and consensus. Finally, Keisuke, the chairman of UPF, presented a vision and peace ideology specifically focusing on Europe and the Middle East and the role of UN and UPF in these regions.

After the riveting presentations, the speakers engaged in thoughtful exploration of various facets, especially the roles of religions and the UN in actualizing the peace ideology and vision of the True Parents. This symposium provided a robust platform for exchanging academic ideas, encouraging lively discussions, and inviting questions. This unique combination of activities was aimed at fostering the academic foundation required to realize world peace, achieved through relentless research and understanding myriad perspectives and prospects.

Hosted at the Jamsil Lotte Hotel as part of the Think Tank 2022 breakout sessions, this meeting addressed contemporary challenges to global well-being and ways to advance toward a “world culture of peace,” (Europe · Middle East).”

Under the chairmanship of Michael Jenkins, President of UPF USA, the attendees included IAPP Co-Chair Dan Burton, Senior Pastor Paula White Cain of the Church of Destiny in the United States, Bolivian House of Representatives member Betty Beatriz Yañiquez Lozano, Petrobusi Mabimbela, Speaker of the Kingdom of Eswatini, Chairman Charanjit Singh of Chairman, Hayer Group of Companies; International Trustee of Religions for Peace, and Malte Kaufmann Member of the German National Assembly, among others.

Unified in their resolve, these legislators affirmed that “The unification of the Korean Peninsula and world peace, must be achieved.” Established in South Korea’s National Assembly in February 2016, the IAPP aims to solve complex global issues and foster peace, engaging over 150 parliamentarians from 41 countries. Guided by Chair Tageldin Hamad, the discourse concentrated on the peace-making role of religious leaders, particularly on the Korean Peninsula, and underlined the necessity of religious freedom to cultivate sustainable peace worldwide. The IAPD was founded to explore paths towards peace and unification of the Korean Peninsula, engaging religious leaders and heads of religious organizations from over 70 countries. 



International Association of First Ladies for Peace (IAFLP) Session

After that day, the IAFLP session was successfully held, attracting an audience of former and current first ladies and female leaders from across the world. Overseen by Mrs. Kaeleigh Moffitt, President, WFPW-USA & International Vice President of North America, the session featured inspiring keynote speeches from a range of influential women.

Opening Remarks: Mrs. Moriko Hori, President of WFPW International, highlighted the pivotal role mothers play in educating children about local community, national, and global issues, and advocated for fostering hope for the future through education and parental support. The participants concurred on the necessity to build bridges of peace across communities and nations through love, understanding, and consideration, thereby addressing the underlying causes of conflict and violence.

Launched in South Korea on February 5, 2020, the International Association of First Ladies for Peace (IAFLP) aspires to disseminate the women's peace movement and realize a harmonious world of peace by networking with global female leaders. 



PEACE SUMMIT 2023: IAYSP Conference

On May 4, the International Association of Youth Students for Peace (IAYSP) held an illuminating conference as part of PEACE SUMMIT 2023 at the Lotte Hotel World, Jamsil, Songpa-gu, Seoul. Themed “The Role of Future Generations in Solving the Climate Crisis and Reducing Educational Disparities,” the conference drew a diverse and dynamic group of participants.

This congregation of forward-thinking minds included the former President of the Republic of Kiribati, H.E. Anote Tong, esteemed Afghan refugee education activist Dr. Sakena Yacoobi, domestic activists, and over 100 young leaders from various fields, including the Minister for Youth.

During his welcoming speech, IAYSP President Matsuda Koji expressed his hope that the conference would ignite earnest contemplation on practical solutions to the climate crisis and the promotion of equitable education.

Highlighting the stark realities of climate change, H.E. Anote Tong described the distressing disappearance of multiple islands underwater, leading to mass migration to neighboring countries such as Fiji. He drove home the point that failing to address the current climate crisis could result in a world populated by climate refugees.

Echoing this sentiment, Kim Hyun-tae, a young environmental activist and CEO of ECO, suggested that IAYSP host an international climate youth conference. Sharing his experience of meeting H.E. Anote Tong at the Paris Climate Agreement where he represented Korea, Kim urged immediate action to safeguard our planet.

Dr. Sakena Yacoobi spoke passionately about the alarming illiteracy rate among Afghan women, currently at 87%. She highlighted her unwavering dedication to advancing education within refugee camps, serving over 13 million refugees and reinforcing the understanding that education is an inherent human right.

Choi Jeong-eun, who heads the Borderless Study Room, a project aimed at reducing educational disparity in Korea, expressed her deep admiration for Dr. Yacoobi’s efforts in Afghanistan. She committed to persist in her quest to ensure equal educational opportunities for multicultural families and individuals.

Expressing his support, Kim Dong-yeon, the Korean IAYSP President, pledged donations to the Afghan Institute of Learning, founded by Dr. Yacoobi. He also voiced his support for H.E. Anote Tong, demonstrating the organization’s ongoing interest and cooperation in these global causes.

Jim Rogers, Chairman of Rogers Holdings and a globally renowned investor, observed, “Historically, peaceful relations thrived among countries that embraced trade.” He envisaged a future where the 38th parallel dividing North and South Korea ceases to exist, giving way to interaction, trade, and shared experiences over tea and meals between the two Koreas.
