

Tongil Foundation's Salary Round-off Funds Syrian Refugee Camp Elementary Education

This is the progress of the funding enterprise for the Syrian Refugee Camp Elementary Education, which was selected through the 2015 Tongil Group Salary Round-Off Enterprise.

The funding enterprise for the Syrian Refugee Camp Elementary Education is working to offer opportunities for children, who have left their country, and have been residing in the refugee camps without being able to receive basic education, to be able to receive at least elementary education.

The funding enterprise for the Syrian Refugee Camp Elementary Education began with the construction of two tents.

These tents will be used as a temporary elementary school, children's play room and library. At the elementary school, thirty-six children over the age of seven and eighteen children under seven will receive education including Arabic, English and mathematics lessons.



Currently, after completing the construction of the temporary elementary school tents, English and Arabic

language professors will be hired, and textbooks and other educational materials are being gathered through systematic education efforts.



They are working very hard to manage this elementary education program so that these children can go back to Syria after the war and develop into adults who can contribute to the development of their country.
