Gwangju Buk-gu Marching Forward for Harmonious Unification Rally Held with Great Success

The "Gwangju Buk-gu Marching Forward for Harmonious Unification of the Nation Rally" was held at the Buk-gu Regional Council Conference Room on July 30, at 2 pm (photo).
