40-day	July 6(Wed) – Aug. 14(Sun), 2011	Blessed children(and *Sung Hwa Students) in high school, 16~18 years of age or in grades 10-12, who understand English*
21-day	July 6(Wed) - July 26(Tue), 2011	Blessed children(and Sung Hwa Students) in junior high school, 12~15 years of age or in grades 6-9, Those high school children that cannot attend full 40-day workshop, who understand English **
	July 25(Mon) - Aug. 14(Sun), 2011	

^{*} Sung Hwa Students (Blessed Children and Jacob's Children) refers to the students of our church who are attending high school or junior high school.

^{**} It is strongly recommended that those Sung Hwa Students in junior high school participate in the 21-day workshop, but if the child strongly wishes to attend the 40-day workshop, please contact international office or the USA Headquarters' Education Department Office(If you are from USA) beforehand.

^{***} If a Sung Hwa Studnet (in junior high school or high school) completes two 21-day workshops (one this time and one before, or one this time and one at a later time), they can receive a 40-day workshop certificate at the end of their second 21-day workshop.

Attending a workshop in Cheong Pyeong is a big investment, as well as a potentially significant experience in our Unificationist life of faith – so we encourage you to consider going when the time is right. Each year we often have a sizeable group attending from the UK – so it is helpful to know who is planning to go.
