Hosted at the Jamsil Lotte Hotel as part of the Think Tank 2022 breakout sessions, this meeting addressed contemporary challenges to global well-being and ways to advance toward a "world culture of peace," (Europe · Middle East)."

Established in South Korea's National Assembly in February 2016, the IAPP aims to solve complex global issues and foster peace, engaging over 150 parliamentarians from 41 countries.
