# UNIFICATION PHILOSOPHY

Unification Precisiphy is the philosophy of Rev. Sun Myung Moort this philosophy was then systematized by the late Dr. Seng Hun Lee as Unification Triought. The course explores various frameworks of interpretation in order to expend the meening and horizon of Rev. Moon's philosophical ideas within and beyond Unification Thought. It focuses on articulating the chilosophical principles in Rev. Moon's religious thought, explores their philosophical implications, and examines their plausibility 3 credits.



Taught by Dr. Keisuke Noda, Professor of Philosophy and Academic Deen at UTS He is a philosopher with a background in phenomeology and herneneutics.
