

Children of Cain: The Mind of Putin lecture in Salzburg, Austria

In the beautiful town of Salzburg the lecture "The Mind of Putin" took place. For the meeting, a physiotherapist offered the rooms located in the heart of the old town. The audience included members and numerous guests; the room was packed with 23 persons.
