  - NHQ board of 3, headed by NL, day-to-day affaires
  - Departments implement instructions, give feedback
- 2. Information and directions
  - Top-down: I/EHQ ã NL ã NHQ ã Departments/Comm.
  - Bottum-up: Other way around, adjust directions to Nat. situation, give feedback

# Objectives of the strategy of The Netherlands

### Ist Objective: Fine tuning the overall organization

- 3. Define Departments
  - Department is committee of minim. 3 pers. Incl. I SG
  - with clearly defined responsibility and accountability
- 4. Evaluation
  - NHQ meets once every two weeks to monitor and evaluate results
  - Departments and NHQ meet monthly to evaluate

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Objective: Establishing Witnessing (inside out)

- Developing a Blessed Family (true love) culture by small gatherings and study in the Hoon Dok Churches
- 3. Setting up education and activities in the realm of Dong Ban Home Church witnessing and Tribal Messiah -outreach

# Objectives of the strategy of The Netherlands

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Objective: Establishing Witnessing (inside out)

- 4. Creating a witness infrastructure enabling I<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> gen members to develop their grassroots outreach by means such as:
  - η Witnessing material (leaflets, TP autobiography, approach books, charts etc.)
  - η Website explaining DP, TP and the Blessing

#### **Threats**

η̃lf we work insensitively, just focusing on the goals of witnessing, we may lose our connection to many members, 2<sup>nd</sup> gens and AfPs.

η̃lf we work too lightly, focusing only on good relation-ships, we cannot raise the spirit nor bring success. This will cause everybody to be unfulfilled in the end.

ῆWe therefore must work hard, even under pressure, while at the same time developing our Bl. Family culture and Community culture of True Love. To harmonize these elements will take time.

# Project 2020 $\tilde{\alpha}$ The Netherlands Summary of the goals for 2020
