THE TORU GOTO CASE IN JAPAN ABDUCTED AND CONFINED FOR OVER 12 YEARS

- . Toru Goto confined by relatives for 12 years and five months for religious 'deprogramming' by an Evangelical pastor and another person
- Brother, sister-in-law and sister to pay about 150,000 €.
- Deprogrammer Takashi Miyamura to pay about 75,000 €
- + Evangelical pastor Yasutomo Matsunaga to pay about 30,000 €
- . UN Human Rights Committee denounced the persistent impunity of a cultural practice in Japan



Tokwo High Court issued a ruling ordering five people (three close relatives of the victim, an Evengelical paster and unother person) to pay damages.

to foru Goto, a victim of abduction. and attempts of forceful miligious deconvention in confinement conditions. from September 1995 to February 2008.

The first three trial defendants this brother. sister-in-law and younger sister) were ordered to pay a total amount of 150,000 €. and wife, and younger sister, kidnapped.

Pastor Yasutomo Matsuraga of the Nittsu-Evangelical Christian Church (Nitigata Cityl) was ordered to pay 30,000 € and arother professional deprogrammer. Mr. Takzuliii Miyamuris, 15,000 f.

Until now, Japanese courts have dismissed the illegal nature of abduction and attempted forceful religious deconversion in confinement conditions they have routinely ruled that such cases were not criminal but "more talks between parents and children." More aromen than men are victims of this practice. In Japanese culture, parents consider children to be under their authority recorders of acid.

Toru Goto's case may also discretized as a criminal case but exceptionally not as a

AND ACTION AND COMPRESSORT

In 1986, Mr. Golo, then 23, became a member of the Unification Church. In 1987, there was a first attempt of kidnapping and conferement by his father and other relatives but he managed to escape about a month later. In order to audid another similar experience. Ne cut: off all the links with his family.

Eight years later, in September 1995, the parents of the plaintiff, his elder brother

him from their frome in Heya City (Tokyo) according to instructions from deprogrammer Takashi Miyamura and Yasutomo Matsunaga, a Christian minister. For about 12 years, he was detained by his family in various apartments. which had been technically equipped für confinement conditions. Pastor Massurage regularly visited him to urge hum to leave the Church, knowing he was deprived of his freedom by his family.

During his confinement, Mr. Gotoattempted to escape several times but he was caught every time. Even when he had: influence and developed a high lever, he was not allowed to visit a clinic.

In November 2007 it seems as though family members started arguing about whether to go on with the confinement or not, due to the financial burdens it Imposed in February 2008, his brother. has stated in law, his mother and his sister suddenly ordered him to leave the apartment. He was then emaciated and suffering from a serious state of starvation He was hospitalized and diagnosed with mulnutrition. For a while, he could havely stand on his feet.

THE LEGAL PROPE

In April 2008, My. Goto submitted a cominal complaint to the Ophiubic Police Station. However, the police did not

and turned the case over to the Tokyo District Fublic Prosecutor's Office.

On 9º December 2009, the prosecution decided to waive the indictment of the criminal complaint on the arounds of insufficient evidence

On 23* June 2010, Mr. Goto appealed to the Tokyo Committee for the Inquest of Prosecution with the hope of reopening the criminal case.

On 6" October 2010, Mr. Gold's appeal was rejected on the ground that there were too many doubts to consider the case as an attempt of compulsion, capture. confinement and injury

On 31° January 2011, he filed a chill lawsuit against his family members and the depropriatives.

The 13th November 2014 ruling was a landmark vectory for Toru Goto and for the members of his Japanese Association of Victims of Abduction and Forced Religious De-Convenion

In 2013, the annual reports of the U.S. Commission on International Religious Freedom and the U.S. State Department cited Japan's judicial potem for turning

a blind eye to the kidnapping and forced decongramming of people in the Unification Church and other new eligious movements over the past

EMPLIFICES FOR YO'S POLICY OF DIRECTOR A DEAF EAR In July 2015, Human Rights Without

Ficantiers submitted a report on the neneral issue of attempts of forceful change of religion in Japan to the Human Rights Committee in order to bring to their attention its concerns about the total impunity of non-state actors who abdurted and confined converts to new religious movements until they recard their new religious faith.

On 14th November 2015, the problem was sixted by the Human Rights Committee in its list of insues addivessed to Japan in the liskowing terms. Please comment. on reports of cases of abduction, forced conversion and forced de-conversion. which were not investigated and presecuted by the State party?



On 15-16" July 3014, Japan's human right record was reviewed in the framework

of the 131th session of the UN Human. Rights Committee.

On 20th August 2014, the UN Human Rights Committee wrote in its Concluding Observations

"Moduction and forced de-conversion

The Committee is concurred at reports of abductions and forced confinement of converts to new seligious movements by members of their families in an effort to deconvert there (arts, 2 st. 16, 26).

The State party should take effective measures to quarantee the right of every person not to be subject to coercion that would impair his or her freedom to have or to adopt a religion or belief."

In the last 40 years, hundreds of adult members of new religious movements mainly the Unification Church and Jeffcraft's Witnesses - were kidropped and confined by their family to be de-

On 7th Newsonbury 2014, a crossele Button in Hiroshima City submitted a criminal charge against their family, a pastor and other kidruppers for being abducted, confined for six days until their escape and subjected. to attempted forcible de-conversion

For more than one year, Masato tchissashi has been missing from his church and his job when initing his family at New Year. Although he had sent a call for help to a feliow believer and had left a written statement to his takener asking for to be rescued in case of disappearance, the policy refused to summon his pavents.








Voice of Peace UPF Magazine for Italy and San Marino
