
Düsseldorf Chapter Holds Online Open-Door Day

Düsseldorf, Germany - An online Open-Door Day invited Ambassadors for Peace and other guests to reflect on past UPF activities and look forward to an active future.

UPF-Düsseldorf leaders Sergio and Anja Brina led the meeting, which was held on May 16, 2021.
