

Following is a brief Biography of Roderick from his Pastor Rev. Gregorio Agulan

Roderick Herradura Natoc, the youngest child of Elpidio and Perla Natoc, was born on October 20, 1977 in Tacusang Sultan Kudarat, Philippines. He has four siblings - three sisters and a brother- Emilie, Benilda, Maribel and Eddie.

Roderick graduated from the University of Southern Mindanao (USM), where he obtained a Bachelor of Science degree in Electronics. He joined the Unification Movement in 1999 in General Santos City.

Roderick came to the United States in 2006 to undertake mission work, and was eventually matched and blessed with Liwayway Damian. He is survived by his loving wife and two beautiful daughters - Kylie Danielle and Elinor Louise.

Roderick is the first Filipino missionary to give up his life for God's providence on U.S. soil.
