

The New Frontiers of Dialogue and Freedom of Belief in Italy's House of Parliament

The latest event "The New Frontiers of Dialogue and Freedom of Belief" took place on the 16th of January 2018 in the Chamber of Deputies, house of the Italian Parliament. The partner was: LIREC Center for Studies on Freedom of Religion, Belief and Conscience. Elisabetta Nistri, president of WFWP Italy, was invited by a member of the advisory board of LIREC to give a speech on the following topic: "The status of dialogue between religions and between believers and non-believers." Religious leaders from several denominations attended the conference and were present as speakers. Raffaella di Marzio presented the guidelines, foundations and strategies that the center intends to implement to favor a secular approach to the problem of religion, spiritual and non-religious minorities, with all the social, political and juridical consequences generated by the diffusion of these realities.

Elisabetta Nistri reported about the early history of our movement, including the persecutions that the founder Rev. Moon had to go through under the communist government in North Korea.

Nevertheless, she continued, Rev. Moon followed the revelation from Jesus and started to work for the unity of Christian churches and then for families, realizing that God-centered families are the base for world peace.

Elisabetta concluded the speech by explaining that religions play a very important role in making peace. A big summit with politicians and religious leaders from all over the world, that cooperate for solutions to our world's problems will take place soon in Korea.
