Excellent speakers reported on the status of women's rights, referring to their own experiences in their respective fields in leadership roles, society and families, reminding of the importance of point 5 of the UN SDG 2030 (Sustainable Development Goal 5: Achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls)

Other topics were addressed such as violence against women and children, the Charta of Girl's Rights, feminine value in today's society, education in the school as prevention against violence.

Elisabetta Nistri thanked all the speakers and women that have been fighting in the past and set up the foundation for many victories along the way; she then proposed the vision of WFWP und underlined that now is the time to look for both feminine and masculine virtues to build a better society
