

WFWP Italy's Women of Faith: Different Spiritualities From a Female Perspective

Elisabetta Nistri, President of WFWP Italy, was invited by Raffaella di Marzio, Director of LIREC (Freedom of believe and conscience), to be a speaker with other religious women leaders representing their faith (Buddhism, Hinduism, Pentecostal, Evangelical Churches, Interreligious

Observatory on violence against women, and with Sen. Rampi, Sen. Fedeli and MP Ceccanti.

The purpose was to report and share about the situation of women inside their own religion, how much women's value has been recognized, and if they are able to attend religious

practices and be leaders at the same level as men. The topic was also to share the spirituality from women's perspective.



Elisabetta Nistri represented two organizations, WFWP and FFUWP, and in 20 minutes explained that men and women are both representing Characteristics of God, and have the same value as reported from Genesis - that is the first declaration of Human Rights. We have a spark of divinity inside each of us.

She shared also the basis of Rev. Moon's revelation on the Divine Principle about the 1st and 2nd Blessing, and about the value of the family as school of love. She underlined that after Rev. Moon's ascension, Mother Moon led and is still leading all the organizations for peace with a motherly heart and so much practical wisdom, calling all women to come to the front line to work for peace, leading by example. Indeed, WFWP was founded with the purpose to help women to recognize their own original value and encourage them to cooperate together to create a culture of peace, together with men.
