About Peace Road 2020:

Guided by a heart of reconciliation, Peace Road 2020 visits sites of great historical accomplishment, as well as suffering and injustice, throughout America this summer. Peace Road 2020 was created by Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon,

affectionately known as the Mother of Peace, to foster dialogue, unity and prayerful encouragement of the best within ourselves.

Summary of This Event:

A scenic bicycling trek along the Potomac River to the National Mall on a safe, dedicated bicycle trail (the paved and car-free Capital Crescent Trail that runs from Bethesda to Georgetown), visiting several historical sites along the Mall, including the Lincoln Memorial, the Martin Luther King Memorial, the WWII memorial and the Capitol. Lunch will be picnic style (you bring your lunch). This is a leisurely route that is accessible to riders of all abilities. You can ride with more experienced cyclists or go at more leisurely pace for kids and slower riders.

We will have lunch in the shadow of the MLK memorial. There are bikes available for rent at the start (Capital Bikeshare) if you do not have one. See the map below for the route. Due to COVID-19, social distancing (six feet) will be observed on the trail. The event is outdoors and facemasks are not needed while riding, but facemasks should be worn if gathering more closely and on the Metro when returning to Bethesda.
