The second conference in the series of 'No Peace Without Women' was held on 13th June 2023, at the Parliament in Pristina, Kosovo with the title "What are Women bringing to Peace Processes, Conflict Prevention, and Human Security in the Balkans?"

Sally Becker, a humanitarian aid worker credited with saving hundreds of children's lives during the Kosovo war, captivated the audience with her testimony.
