

## Tongil Group donates computers to missionaries

deliver the laptops safely to the missionary fields in need around the world.

A total of 50 secondhand laptops; nine by Tongil Foundation, three by the Missionary Association Foundation, two by the FFWPU, 10 by Ilhwa Co.Ltd., 18 by the Yongpyong Resort, five by the Segye Ilbo, two by individuals (Rev. Jin-Jong Kim, North Pusan Church and Presbyterian Gap-Yong Kim, Seongbuk Church), and one by the Ilsang Ocean Development were donated.



From 2012, the Tongil Group has practiced “*Huimang* (Hope) Dream Donation of Monthly Pay Remaining Sum” by gathering a small amount not exceeding 10,000 won from executives and staff members’ monthly pay to support various organizations in need.
