

FFWPU UK: Highlights From The Scottish Community's Christmas Retreat

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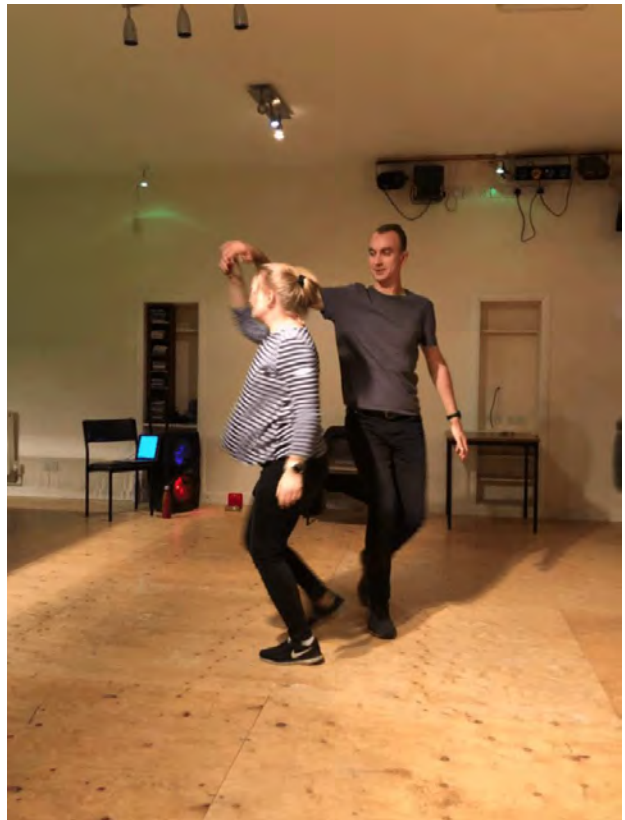
'Our Scottish Christmas retreat was definitely a 2023 highlight for many.
