WFP Burkina Faso organized a workshop in Lycée Bogodogo with students from the Ouagadougou International School in six different cities and schools.

Each workshop was attended by 50 to 250 children.



The educational curriculum included topics such as self-esteem, the four realms of heart, and moral education.

School officials welcomed the project and saw it as a resource to support youth, especially young girls, in their struggle in education.

Through this project, 942 young people, mostly girls, were educated this school year.
