In early January 1992, we went to Gdansk with several brothers and sisters, Serge, Gerard, Parisa, Donna, ... in a van.

French unification movement was responsible to help Polish Unification Movement to develop after so many years working underground under communist regime putting their life at risk with the help of some Austrian missionaries. In this winter months, the temperature was often under -20 Celsius degrees.



And we had some metal barrels with stuff burning inside in the middle of the streets to warm ourselves, when we witnessed.

We met many Polish people that explained the difficult life they had during communist time, so to find some apartments: they divided a house in several parts to accommodate several families.



Anyway, many were interested to come to listen to our lectures and afterwards to come to our 3 or 7-days workshop in our training center in Warszawa.

We did sometimes fundraising to support our center with nice cards that Polish people appreciated very much. I stay myself six months and I was very happy to share with Polish people. During this time, we were honored with the visit of our elder brother, Rev. Won Pil Kim.
