The finalists were determined by an Evaluation Team, which included Dr. Paris Moon, Mrs. Su Youn Kim, Mrs. Katarina Connery, Ms. Chika Yasojima. Each application was evaluated in four areas: (1) cost-effective: 30 points; (2) feasibility: 30 points; (3) social impact: 30 points; and (4) originality: 10 points. The finalists were determined by the number of points they received.

We would like to express our appreciation to President Moon for her full support and for providing the funding through WFWPI HQ.

It is our hope that this is just the beginning, that WFWPI can establish a tradition of recognizing and supporting projects on an annual basis.
