

Demonstration protesting True Mother's new versions of Cheon Seong Gyeong and the Peace Messages

Some 200 supporters of Hyun Jin Nim protested in front of the church HQ in Korea the replacement original version of the Cheon Seong Gyeong and the Peace Messages with updated versions. They did a demonstration in front of the church headquarters on Sunday.



They claim that up to 80% of the content of the original Cheon Seong Gyeong has been removed and replaced in the new version. They are asking for the restoration of the original Cheon Seong Gyeong, Peace Messages, and Family Pledge.



Hyun Jin Nim's supporters feel that there are leaders who are trying to define God's will in a particular way which they don't agree with. True Mother's changing of the Cheon Seong Gyeong and Peace Messages is part of the process of their new definition.



The supporters weren't only protesting the changes to the text, but also protesting the way parts of the current leadership used the changes of the texts and other traditions in ways to justify their legitimacy and cement their power. The changing of these texts is just a part of a bigger program... They have some pretty radical changes they want to implement.



There is an analysis of the changes being translated right now. Currently there's only the Korean version. And it's a long text, so the translation is taking some time. I think the demonstrators also handed out that analysis to members who were coming out of the church service.
